We are excited to inform you about the opening of a new flagship **Sky Up digital support hub** in **Edgeley** on **Friday 16th June at 12 noon**. It will be one of ten flagship Sky community hubs in the UK and the only one in the northwest. The hub is also supported by match funding from Stockport Council as part of their commitment to make Stockport a radically digital borough.

The hub will offer a welcoming, comfortable community space where people can use Sky's devices and wifi for free and get help with tech and doing things online. We plan to run regular workshops, support sessions and drop-in sessions, all supported by Sky Cares volunteers (and a free cuppa)! The digital support hub is at 2 Castle Street, Edgeley, Stockport SK3 9AB, close to Stockport train station and the town centre.

Sky Partnership Celebrated



The fantastic partnership between Age UK National and Sky recently won the 'Community Impact' award at this year's Third Sector Business Charity Awards! In Stockport we have certainly seen the benefit of this partnership.

In 2019, Sky launched their '**Sky Cares**' volunteering programme with Age UK as their flagship loneliness charity. Since then, Sky employees have been volunteering with local Age UKs across the country, giving their time to make friendship calls; hosting tea parties for older people in their communities; supporting local services; and galvanising their engineers to support with emergency food and care package drop offs during the pandemic. Last year alone, Sky delivered more than 4,500 hours of community volunteering throughout the UK.

In Stockport they helped us throughout the pandemic by delivering shopping to people who couldn't get out and by making friendship calls. They helped deliver warm packs last winter, they have invited us to celebrations at the Sky offices in Stockport and supported the digital drop ins. They have really made a difference to the lives of the people of Stockport and now we have the Sky Up Digital Hub opening.

Alternatively you can book them through the Stockport Plaza box office which is open Wednesday to Saturday and for an hour before each performance.

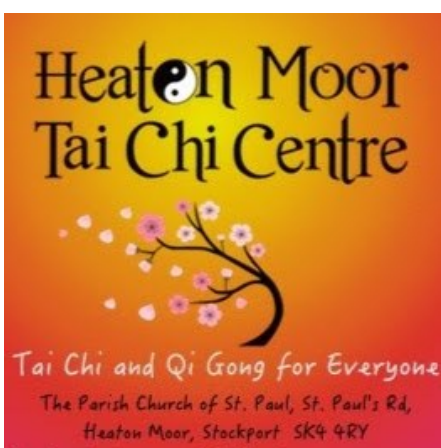
Carers Week 5 - 11 June

Carers Week is an annual campaign to raise awareness of caring, highlight the challenges unpaid carers face and recognise the contribution they make to families and communities throughout the UK. It also helps people who don't think of themselves as having caring responsibilities to identify as carers and access much-needed support.

Caring for a friend or relative can be hugely rewarding – but it can also be challenging. So it's good to know what support is available for you and the person you care for. It covers things like benefits and flexible working hours, as well as how your caring role could affect your wellbeing and social life.
