

Recruitment Opportunity: Community Autism Training

We are looking for two autistic individuals to:

- Co-design autism training sessions alongside a task and finish group
- Deliver a mixture of live and recorded autism training sessions alongside The Strategic Lead for Autism

The training will be for local businesses in Stockport to improve awareness, acceptance and inclusion as set out in the new all-age Autism Strategy for Stockport 2023-2026.

We are seeking your help to develop the following training packages:

- 1) Basic autism awareness and inclusion training for local businesses in Stockport
- 2) Employer training to support autistic staff and make reasonable adjustments
- 3) Three bespoke training sessions to businesses identified by our local autistic community (Jobcentre staff, Stockport Homes staff, Stockport Council staff)

Payment:

£300 per half day (4 hours) this includes any expenses including meals and travel. Refreshments will be provided.

Requirements

- Previous involvement in co-designing/ co-delivering autism training
- Availability to plan and deliver all of the sessions
- Be able to work as part of a task and finish group, meeting the training brief

Hours required:

- Basic training Package: total of 3 half days
- Employer training package: total of 3 half days
- Bespoke training package: total of 9 half days
