Salford CVS manage the fund on behalf of 10GM.



Overview of the fund

Grants of up to £5000 for Greater Manchesterbased VCSE organisations to deliver projects that raise awareness of the early signs and symptoms of cancer, engage communities in conversations around cancers and how to access timely healthcare and identify and understand the barriers people face when receiving a cancer diagnosis.

- The focus of round 1 was to get conversations about cancer diagnosis and the inequalities started in communities.
- Round 2 is looking for projects to continue raising awareness, educating and finding out the barriers people face when it comes to early diagnosis but sharing tlearning from these activities with the wider health care system.
- Round 3 will be about creating practical interventions to address barriers and increase early cancer diagnosis rates.

It is not about increasing cancer screening uptake. It is cancer about early cancer diagnosis.

Your organisation may already deliver health and engagement activities or you may be a well trusted and respected organisation in your community. This fund wants groups like these to apply, it is these skills and experiences that will encourage people to share their opinions and feedback on cancer signs and symptoms, early diagnosis, barries; etc. This on the ground information is what can make a big impact when fed back up to the wider health care system.

Think about how you can gather information, what engages your communtiies and how you can get this information up to make changes.

- Consider how you will continue to raise awareness of early cancer diagnosis after your project has completed.
