Attending appointments in summer / warm weather ?

Please bring a snack and drink with you to your appointment, it is important to keep hydrated in the warm weather. Sometimes our clinics do run over or transport can be delayed meaning you may miss a meal time which can be important when living with diabetes.

Remember to bring your sunglasses as your eyes may feel sensitive to sunlight after the eye drops. This feeling is normal and can last up to 6 hours
