

Help develop our new learning disability service

We're developing a new short breaks service for people aged 16 to 24 with a learning disability. It'll be the first service of its kind in the country for this age group.

The unit will provide therapy and support for up to 12 weeks, to help people experiencing a crisis to avoid hospital.



People with a learning disability, their family and carers, and professionals are invited to come along to our event to find out more about the service and have your say on our planned building designs and layout.
