- Person-centred approaches

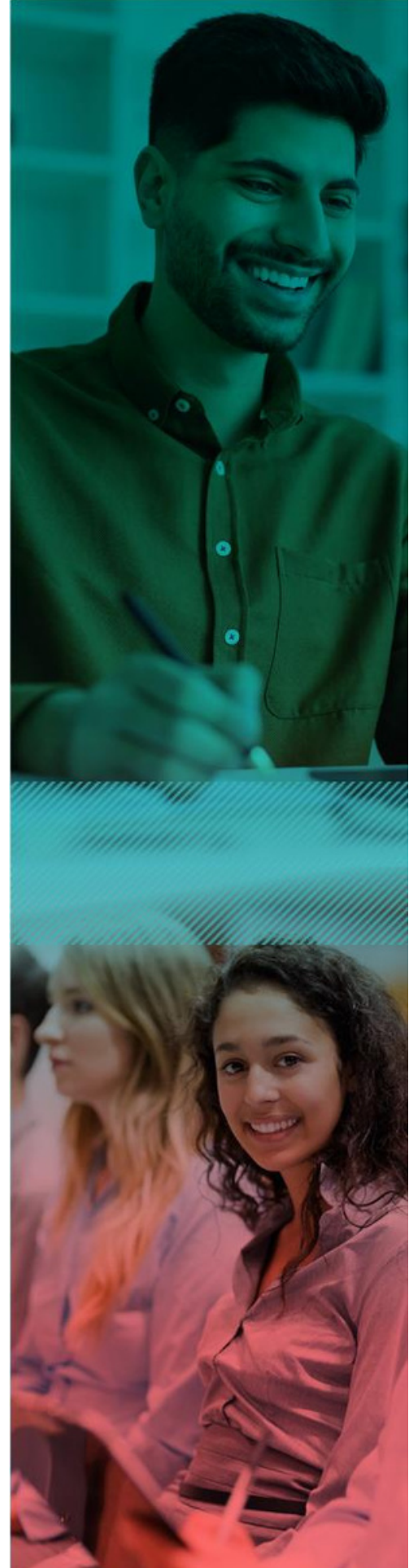
Eligibility criteria
