

Work Experience & Volunteering



Need to gain practical skills and industry experience to boost your CV, college or university applications, or general job prospects? Find out more about accessing work experience in Stockport and what local employers want.

Finding your own work experience placement can be a good experience as it means you'll have more choice and control over where to go and what you'll be doing.

Accessing Work Experience Opportunities in Stockport



Decide on what you want to do

Research what careers you're interested in and figure out what type of placement you're looking for, the skills you want to gain and why is appeals to you



Research potential opportunities

Search local employers in that sector or industry using search engines, social media, directory websites like yell.com or asking friends or family members



Reach out to employers directly

Find out the best contact details and telephone, email or visit potential employers - be sure to have a copy of your CV or covering letter to give them



Follow-up and have conversations

If you don't receive a response straight away, contact the employer again. If they can't offer a work placement, ask if they would be willing to have a call with you about the job they do or for you to call in for a short workplace visit instead



Explore alternative options to gaining work experience

Virtual work experience, online insight days, remote careers talks and in-person volunteering are also great ways to gain experience. **Search what's available here**.
