PRIMARY CARE SERVICES

Clinical Support:

General Practice

Stockport has 37 GP Practices, providing a wide range of healthcare support via GPs, practice nurses, healthcare assistants from 8am-6.30pm Monday-Friday www.stockportccg.nhs.uk/yourhealth/your-health-services/gppractices/

7 Day Access Service

Stockport's GP Federation, Viaduct Care, provides greater access to GP services 6.30-8pm Mon-Fri and 8am-1pm at weekends. You can pre-book appointments with GPs, Practice Nurses and Healthcare Assistants in 8 hubs across Stockport via your GP Practice <u>https://www.viaductcare.org.uk/</u>

Psychological Medicines

Supports people with complex physical health difficulties and unmet psychological needs who often fall through the gaps between existing services. Provides assessment, including medication review, by consultant liaison psychiatrist or clinical psychologist and delivery of intense goal-focussed interventions provided by mental health practitioners. Acute Home Visiting

A team of GPs, Allied Health Professionals and Healthcare Assistants provide urgent assessment and home visits from 8am – 6.30pm Patients seen within 2-4 hours to prevent the need for an ambulance. Access via GP Practice https://www.viaductcare.org.uk/

Minor Eye Conditions
